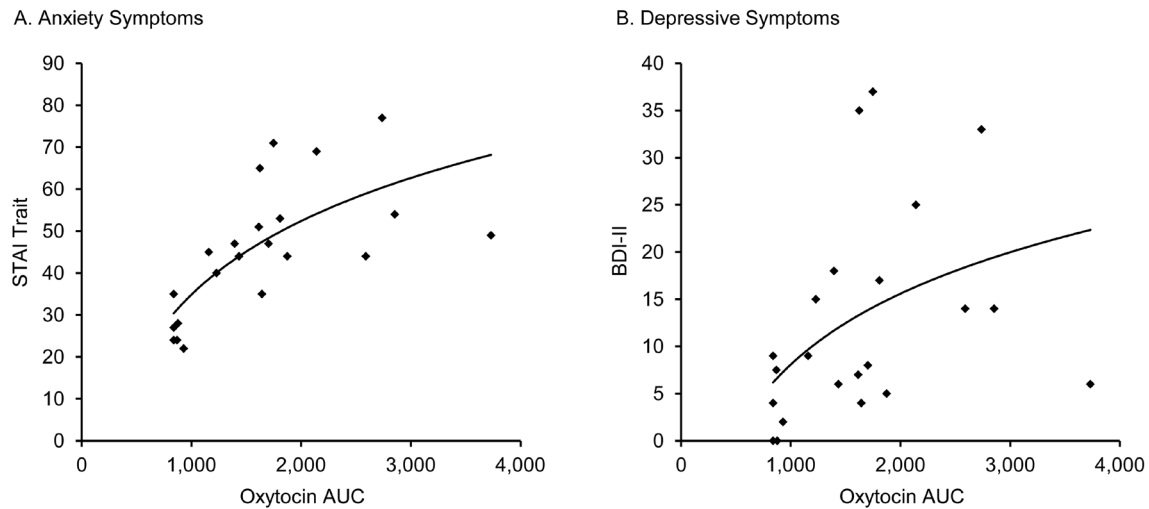


## Correction
